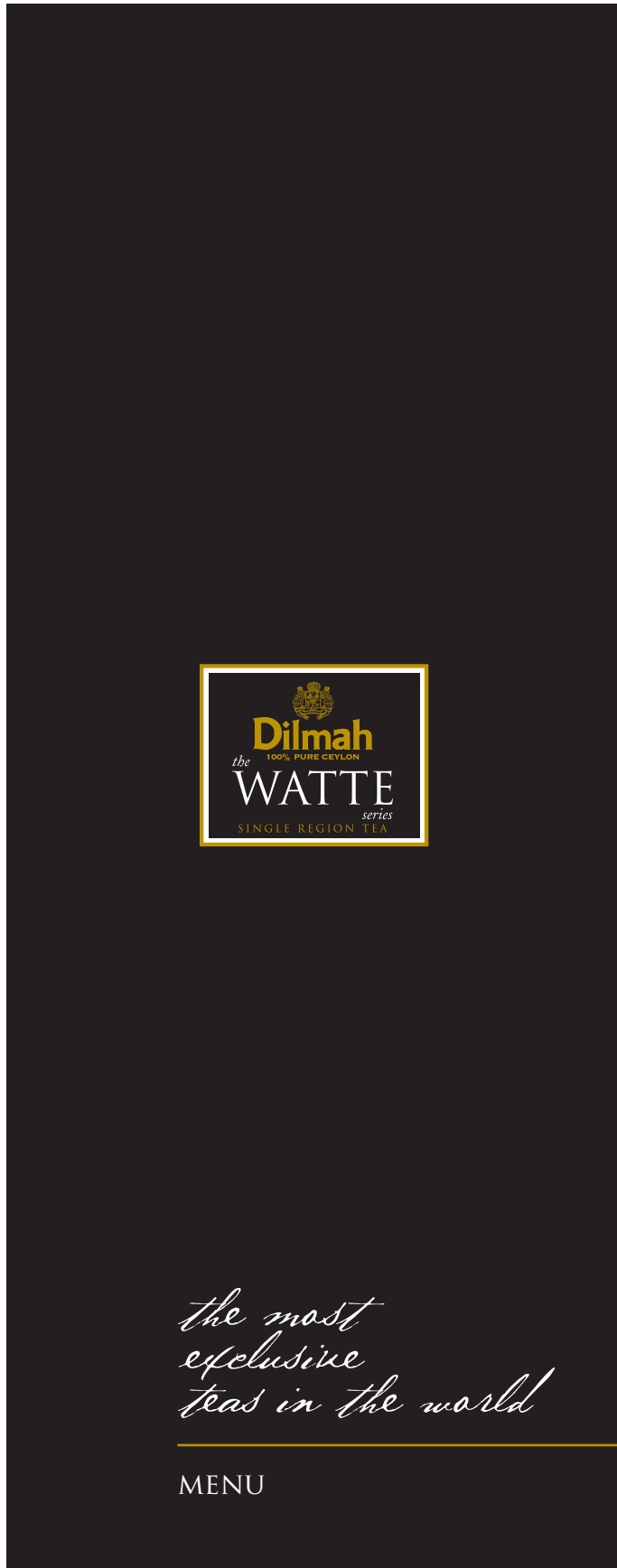


MENU FORMAT WATTE BOUTIQUE TEA

The Dilmah WATTE (meaning estate) series represents the unique qualities of select tea gardens in the four primary tea growing regions of Ceylon - Yata Watte (low elevation), Meda Watte (mid elevation), Uda Watte (high elevation) and Ran Watte (peak elevation).

The unique aspects of a place – climate, soil and topography – influence and shape the tea made there and give it a specific personality, much like terroir in wine.



RAN WATTE

Ran Watte is delicate and mellow, reflecting subtle fragrance, in the style of Chardonnay grapes; best enjoyed late evening or after a meal.



UDA WATTE

Uda Watte is rich, robust, well rounded with a delightful aroma, in the style of Pinot Noir grapes, best enjoyed as morning bed tea, at breakfast and early afternoon.



MEDA WATTE

Meda Watte is strong, full bodied, elegant and velvety on the palate, in the style of Shiraz grapes. Best for afternoon or early evening.



YATA WATTE

Yata Watte is heavy, intense, in the style of Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, the pick of aficionados.
